## TADSAW Programs

TADSAW INC has always looked to improve the programs and communities served. AND at **NO CHARGE** to the Veteran, Client, or their Family members.

TADSAW’s **P**articipant **T**rained **S**ervice **D**og (**PTSD**) program pertains to the training of all the mission statements for the different populations and re-introduced the “Train a Dog – Save a Civilian” (TADSAC) program to include **Children and Community Members” (TADSAC)**. So here is where TADSAW INC changes the course and the culture and seeks to **DESTIGMATIZE the Medical Condition!!!**

TADSAW is most unique in that it is a **P**articipant **T**rained **S**ervice **D**og (**PTSD**) program – meaning the Client, is totally involved in the training of their Medical Alert Service Dog for their diagnosed medical condition, where a Service Dog would be an appropriate addition and beneficial to restore and improve to their Quality of Life and destigmatize the present classification now described as a mental health/mental illness or other medical condition.

**The TADSAW programs mission is to provide for the training of a Medical Alert Service Dog Team, as designated by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990/2010 guidelines, in order to restore and improve the Client’s Quality of Life with a canine ‘Battle Buddy’, at NO CHARGE to the Client or the family.**

### **1) TADSAW – ‘Train a Dog – Save a Warrior’**

For all wounded Veteran Service Members (Active Duty. Retired, Discharged) surviving with **Military Induced Anxiety Depression Syndrome (MIADS)**, post-traumatic stress disorder (ptsd), Military Sexual Trauma (MST) and/or Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), or other medical conditions.

**2) TADSAF – ‘Train a Dog – Save a Family’ member**

For any Veteran’s immediate family, spouse and/or children, including the Gold Star parents or siblings, surviving with compassion fatigue, secondary MIADS/ptsd, or any other physical, psychological or medical condition diagnosed while the Veteran was deployed or on Active Duty

**3) TADSAR – ‘Train a Dog – Save a First Responder’**

For any First Responder, Local and State Police, Fire Fighters, Emergency Medical Personnel, Hospital staff and Veterans Affairs Health Care personnel, surviving with an **Occupation Related Induced Anxiety Depression Syndrome (ORIADS)**, as a direct result of the medical attention provided by the individual while treating the victims and survivors of catastrophic events and/or accidents.

**4) TADSAC – ‘Train a Dog – Save a Child/Civilian/Community’ member**

For all children and community members diagnosed with long term medical conditions or disabilities, in which a Service Dog would restore and improve that person’s Quality of Life and give them a sense of being and belonging. **Behavioral Acquired Anxiety Depression Syndrome (BAADS)** or **Climate Acquired Anxiety Depression Syndrome (CAADS)** or any **Acquired Anxiety Depression Syndrome (AADS)**.

**There is no pharmaceutical preparation available that has the power to restore a person’s self-esteem, self-trust, and self-confidence when compared with the TADSAW PTSD program.**
